ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

Intellectual Property (**IP**) is a category of property that includes intangible creations of the human intellect. There are many types of intellectual property such as patents, copyrights, trademarks and trade secrets. The modern concept of intellectual property developed in England in the 17th and 18th centuries. The term **"Intellectual Property"** began to be used in the 19th century, though it was not until the late 20th century that intellectual property became common place in the majority of the world's legal systems.

Intellectual property rights are the legal rights that cover the benefits given to individuals who are the owners and inventors of work and have created something unique with their intellectual creativity or capability. Every person related to areas such as literature, music, invention, etc., can be granted such rights, which can then be used in their business practices by them.

The creator/inventor gets complete rights against any misuse or use of work without his/her prior information. However, the rights are issued for a limited period of time to maintain equilibrium. Intellectual Properties are industrial designs, scientific discoveries, protection against unfair competition, literary, artistic, and scientific works, inventions in all fields of human endeavour, trademarks, service marks, commercial names and designations.

This workshop will provide an opportunity for the faculty, research scholars, officials and students to enhance their understanding of intellectual property rights. The main objective of the workshop is to give detail information about the protection and enforcement of IPRs for their findings and creations. The second objective is to know about various opportunities of IPR like, it encourages individuals to share information and data, provides legal defence and offers the creators the incentive of their work and inspires people to create new things without fear of intellectual theft. The third objective of the workshop is to know about the challenges that one faces while getting IP rights in India.

ABOUT COLLEGE

Government Girls Degree College Haldwani (Nainital) now renamed "Indira Priyadarshini Govt. Girls P.G. College of Commerce" was established on 28th Feb. 1996 as a result of the long-cherished demand of local public and public representatives for its opening. The college is situated at Nawabi Road Haldwani and has the credit of being the first Government Girls Institution in Uttarakhand. It was started with seven subjects in Arts faculty namely Hindi, English, Psychology and Home Science. Two other Social Science subjects viz. Sociology and Education were granted affiliation in 2001. Commerce and Science faculties were introduced in 2001 and 2005 respectively. At present the college has been offering PG diploma in Vocational Courses namely Yoga and Alternative Therapy. Also, from session 2015-2016 Govt. had started Job oriented Project Utkarsh in PPP mode with leading agencies. New subjects introduced in session 2015-16 were History, Geography, Music and B. Com (Hons.) at UG Level and Chemistry, Physics, Botany, M. Com, M.A (English, Hindi) at PG Level. Research Cell was established in college in year 2017, and now it is renamed as Research and Development Cell in 2022. Under this cell the college is going forward in the field of research in different branches as well as in collaboration with other institutes. Research scholars are awardees of International Conference, Young Scientist, Scholarship (JNMF, New Delhi), NET and GATE.
