- 10- Alumni meets will be organized so as to ensure alumni cooperation in the development of the institution.
- 11- Efforts will be sped up to get an NCC unit introduced in the college.
- 12- Dress code will be strictly implemented in the college.
- 13- Lab equipment will be purchased.
- 14- All the college activities will be organized under the IQAC supervision.
- 15-A number of programmes will be organized in the college under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat in collaboration with the paired Karnataka College.

07/9/2020

Today on September 07, 2020 IQAC meeting held in the chairmanship of Principal. Topics of discussion in this meeting were as under:

1- Efforts will be sped up to get an NCC unit introduced in the college.

- 2- Small construction works will be focused upon with the view of improving basic infrastructure of the college.
- 3- Time to time programmes will be organized to train the class IV employees into the basic official matters.

15/9/2020

This meeting took the following points under consideration:

- 1- Covid-19 SOP will be strictly adhered to in the college premises.
- 2- Students will be allowed to enter the premises only with the approval letter duly signed by their guardian.
- 3- All the entrants into the college will have to go through hand sanitization, and temperature monitoring at the main entrance. Those with a body temperature above 98.6 will be provided primary care and sent back home.
- 4- Hand washing facility will be enhanced in the college.
- 5- Only the students having practical subjects will attend the college, and that too in separate batches.
- 6- During lab work, physical distance of six feet will be maintained.
- 7- Awareness programmes will be run through NCC, NSS, and Ranger group.
- 8- All teaching as well as non teaching staff members will download Arogya Setu app in their mobile phones.
- 9- Career counselling Cell will give priority to programmes on self employment.

The points of discussion in this meeting were as under:

- 1- Class IV employees of the college will be trained into basic official documentation, computer and file maintenance work by the class III employees of the college for 12 working days in the next three months. This will help them go through their work easily after getting promoted to class IV.
